




The Islamic Jesus The Portrait of Jesus in Islamic Literature and Tradition

Alongside the authoritative Koranic stories of Jesus, this anthology presents traditional accounts from the Hadith and other less known sources, whom Daniel Deleanu has collected and co-translated to produce a genuine Islamic gospel.
